Knez Mihailova Street: Stroll down Belgrade's main pedestrian street, lined with shops, cafes, and historical buildings. This bustling area is perfect for soaking in the local atmosphere.

Skopje city walking tour. Stone Bridge which spans the River Vardar. **Old bazaar** which is the biggest bazaar in the Balkans, **Kale Fortress and Macedonia Square**. The walk will continue to the **memorial house of Mother Teresa** who was born in Skopje.











Home to narrow, cobblestoned streets and medieval-esque architecture, a visit to Ohrid may seem like a trip back in time. It is **Lake Ohrid**, Europe's deepest lake (a cultural and natural UNESCO World Heritage site) that makes the city a unique historical artefact.



Visit the church of **St. Giovanni di Kaneo**, located on a small peninsula that juts out towards the lake, and offers spectacular panoramic views of the lake and surrounding mountains, **Ancient Theatre of Ohrid, Fortress Samuil, San Painteleimon Church** and **St Sophia Church**.








Built on a high rocky cliff over the shore of Ohrid Lake is one of the most beautiful monasteries in Macedonia, which also represents one of the first monuments of Slavic church architecture and art in the Ohrid region — **the Monastery of St. Naum**, built 1,000 years ago. Take a boat ride to explore the crystal-clear springs that feed Lake Ohrid, offering a serene and picturesque experience.



If there's one place you have to visit in Albania, it's beautiful medieval **Berat** (UNESCO World Heritage site)— 'the city of a thousand windows'. Discover this wonderful town, home to two ancient neighborhoods (Mangalem & Gorica Quarters), filled with traditional Ottoman houses and divided by the River Osum. Wander the cobblestone streets, bustling bazaar and **Berat Castle**.

Apollonia is the most important archaeological center in Albania and founded in the 6th century B.C by Greek colonists. Visit the amphitheatre, courtyard of the Monastery where there is a Byzantine style church. See the Encircling Wall,

the Monument of Agonotheteve, Odeon, Portic, the Mosaics House, Fontana, and the church of Saints Mary.



Continue to the ancient city of **Durres** founded in 672 B.C. Today Durres is one of the biggest towns and seaport of Albania. Enjoy sightseeing of Durres with the **Roman amphitheater**. Continue to **Tirana** for overnight.





Return to **Tirana** for tour of the Albanian capital. Walk along the main boulevard, see the Main University of Tirana, President Office, Gallery of Arts. Next continue to Skanderbeg Square where for the Palace of Culture, Clock Tower, 18th century E'them Bey Mosque.

TIRANA – PRIZEN, KOSOVO – DECAN – PEJE (1N)



Proceed to the city of **Prizren**, in the south of Kosovo. Second largest city in the country known for its well-preserved Ottoman architecture and vibrant cultural scene.. Visit the central medieval area with **Sinan Pasha mosque**, **Shardervan Square** & **Stone Bridge and Bistrica River**.



Continue to **Decani**, visit the beautiful **Visoki Dečani Monastery (UNESCO)**. It is the largest medieval church in the Balkans and contains the largest Byzantine fresco that has survived to this day.



Continue to Peje for overnight.

PEJE-KOLASIN, MONTENEGRO -PODGORICA (1N)

Embark on a scenic drive through the beautiful landscapes of Kosovo. Arrive in **Kolašin**, a charming town nestled in the heart of the Montenegrin mountains known for its stunning beauty.



Biogradska Gora National Park: Visit one of Europe's last remaining primeval forests. See the park's dense woodlands, crystal-clear lakes, and diverse flora and fauna.



Continue towards **Podgorica**, the capital city of Montenegro. Brief sightseeing tour of the city. **Millennium Bridge**: iconic cable-stayed bridge over the Morača River.



St. George's Church: one of the oldest churches in Podgorica, dating back to the 10th century **King's Park**: Stroll through this centrally located park



Ribnica Bridge: Discover the remains of the old Ottoman bridge over the Ribnica River, offering a glimpse into the city's historical past.









Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Travel to the historic town of Cetinje, the old capital of Montenegro; passing through scenic landscapes and offerin beautiful views of Montenegro's mountainous terrain.

Cetinje Monastery: a significant religious and historical site. The monastery houses important relics, including the right hand of St. John the Baptist and a piece of the True Cross.

King Nikola's Palace: the former royal residence of King Nikola I, now a museum displaying royal family artifacts and period furnishings.



The village of Njeguši, located on the slopes of Mount Lovćen, famous for its traditional Montenegrin cuisine. Enjoy a delicious lunch featuring local specialties.



Continue to Budva, one of Montenegro's most popular coastal towns. Sightseeing tour of this historic and picturesque town. Explore the well-preserved medieval old town, characterized by narrow streets, historic buildings, and charming squares. Visit landmarks such as the Citadel, the Church of St. John, and the Church of the Holy Trinity.



启程前往塞尔维亚首都,贝尔格莱德。

・ 第2天 ・

>> 抵达贝尔格莱德 (2晚)



踏上令人兴奋的观光之旅,游览**贝尔格莱德**这座拥有 丰富历史和文化的城市。



圣萨瓦教堂:首先参观世界上最大的东正教教堂之一。 其令人惊叹的建筑和宁静的内部。

卡菜梅格丹堡垒:探索这座历史悠久的堡垒,欣赏萨瓦河 和多瑙河交汇处的壮丽景色。



米哈伊洛大公街:漫步在贝尔格莱德的主要步行街上,街道两旁遍布商店、咖啡馆和历史建筑。这个繁华的地区非常适合沉浸在当地氛围中。

米兰王广场

漫步穿过尼什的中心广场,周围环绕着重要的地标,例如尼什解放者纪念碑和优雅的尼什巴诺维纳建筑。


》 斯科普里 - 奥赫里德 (1晚)



狭窄的鹅卵石街道和中世纪风格的建筑,游览奥赫里德可能感觉像是一次时光倒流之旅。**奥赫里德湖**是欧洲最深的湖泊(联合国教科文组织世界文化和自然遗产),使这座城市成为独一无二的历史遗迹。



参观圣乔凡尼·迪·卡内奥教堂,该教堂位于向湖面伸出的小半岛上,可欣赏到湖泊和周围群山的壮丽全景,还有奥赫里德古剧场、萨穆伊尔堡垒、圣潘特莱蒙教堂和圣索菲亚教堂。


》 奥赫里德 – 圣纳姆 – 阿尔巴尼亚,培拉特 (1晚)

早餐 / 午餐 / 晚餐

这座修道院建在奥赫里德湖岸边的高耸岩石峭壁上,是 马其顿最美丽的修道院之一,也是奥赫里德地区最早 的斯拉夫教堂建筑和艺术纪念碑之一——建于1000年前 的**圣瑙姆修道院**。乘船游览奥赫里德湖清澈的泉水, 享受宁静而美丽的体验。



如果说在阿尔巴尼亚有一个地方你必须去,那就是美丽的中世纪**培拉特**(联合国教科文组织世界遗产)——"千窗之城"。探索这个美丽的小镇,这里有两个古老的街区(**曼加莱姆区和戈里卡区**),到处都是传统的奥斯曼房屋,被奥苏姆河一分为二。漫步在鹅卵石街道、熙熙攘攘的集市和**焙拉特城堡**。

》 培拉特 - 阿波洛尼亚 - 杜雷斯 - 地拉那 (2晚)

早餐 / 午餐 / 晚餐

阿波罗尼亚是阿尔巴尼亚最重要的考古中心,由希腊殖民者于公元前6世纪建立。参观圆形剧场、修道院庭院,那里有一座拜占庭风格的教堂。

参观围墙,阿戈诺特特夫纪念碑、剧场、门廊、马赛克屋、 丰塔纳和圣玛丽教堂。



继续前往公元前 672 年建立的古城**都拉斯**。如今,都拉斯 是阿尔巴尼亚最大的城镇和海港之一。游览都拉斯,欣赏 **罗马圆形剧场**。继续前往**地拉那**过夜。





比奧格拉德斯卡山国家公园:游览欧洲仅存的原始森林 之一。观赏公园茂密的林地、清澈的湖泊和多样的动植物。



继续前往黑山首都**波德戈里察**。简短的城市观光之旅。 **干禱桥**:横跨莫拉查河的标志性斜拉桥。



圣乔治教堂:波德戈里察最古老的教堂之一,其历史可追溯至10世纪。

国王公园: 漫步穿过这个位于市中心的公园。


