The Chobe National Park, in the north of Botswana, contains one of the biggest concentrations of African elephant. Although the observation of these gentle mammals are a highlight of a visit of Chobe, there is much more to see. Chobe is also a fantastic destination for bird watching and, with the numerous herbivores, it is possible to see some of the big predators of Africa.

Enjoy a **Boma Dinner** with its wide variety of local delicacies, game meat and entertainment.

DAY 4

Victoria Falls

 Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Enjoy the thrill of your life on board a **helicopter ride aptly name "Flight of Angels"** over the magnificent Natural Wonder of the World, Victoria Falls.

Tour of Victoria Falls A spectacular sight of awe-inspiring beauty and grandeur on the Zambezi River, forming the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe. It was described by the Kololo tribe living in the area in the 1800's as 'Mosi-oo-Tunya' – 'The Smoke that Thunders'. In more modern terms Victoria Falls is known as the greatest curtain of falling water in the world. Up to 545 million litres of water flow over the Falls per minute. Afternoon is free at leisure to explore the charming town of Victoria Falls on own.


In the late evening, proceed for **Lunar Rainbow Tour of Victoria Falls which few ever experience!** Each full moon the Victoria Falls rainforest re-opens in the evening for special tours to witness the mystical magic of the lunar rainbow – spray and cloud permitting! Victoria Falls are one of the few places on earth where this natural phenomenon occurs regularly and where it can be witnessed with ease. And yet many people visit the Falls without knowing of this natural phenomenon but it is one of the most impressive sights of Victoria Falls. The lunar rainbow is best seen at times of high water (April to July) when there is sufficient spray to create the moonbow effect.

Afternoon Game Drive at **Etosha National park**.

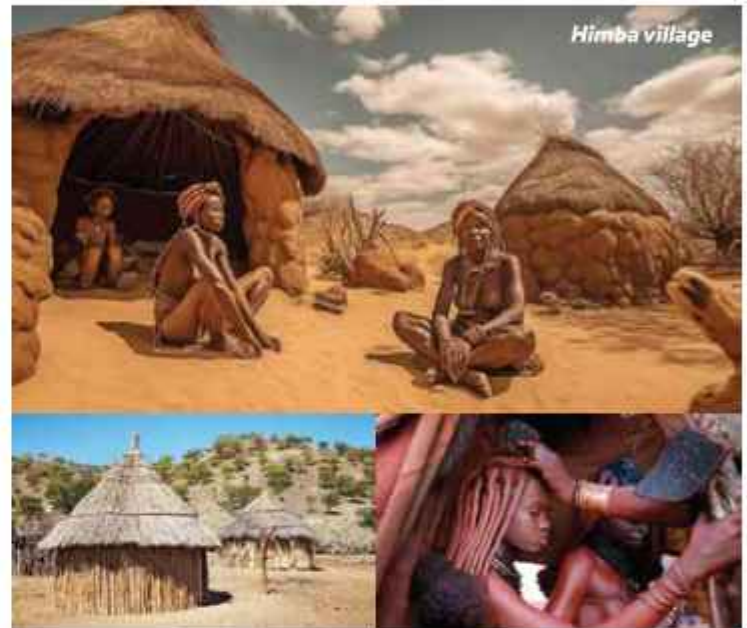

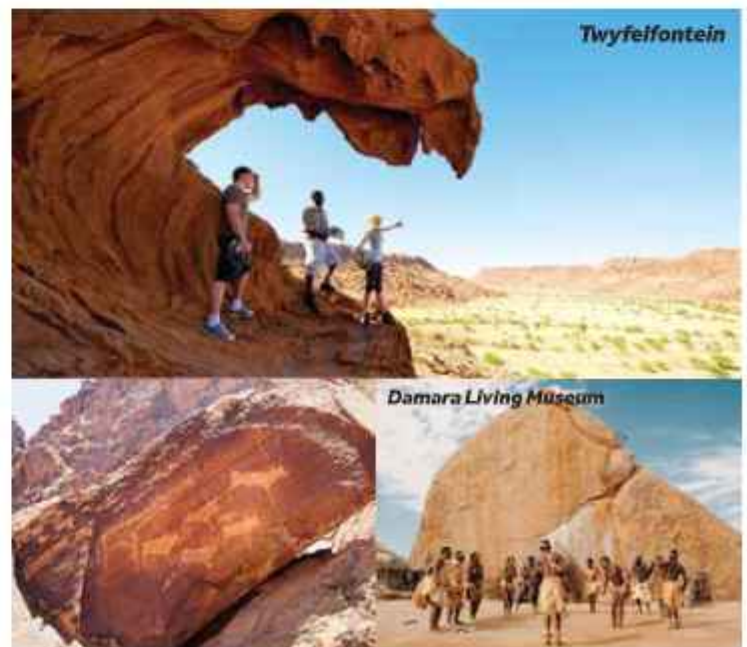

Morning visit to a typical **Himba village**. Damaraland and the Kaokoveld are home to the Himba, one of the last truly traditional tribes on the planet. These friendly people lead a semi-nomadic life as herdsman, breeding mainly cattle and goats.



We depart for **Twyfelfontein (320km)** to visit the **Rock Engravings and Damara Living Museum**. The **Rock Art Site** is recognised as **UNESCO World Heritage site** as the most important rock engraving sites in southern Africa, be inspired by the remarkable 2,000 years in history of wild animals and footprints.

The **Damara Living Museum** is a community project of a village to preserve the original traditions and way of life of the Damara people.









NAMIBIA

Few countries in Africa can match Namibia's sheer natural beauty or as soul stirring. The country's name derives from the world's oldest desert, the Namib, and there are few more stirring desert realms on the planet – the otherworldliness of sand dunes plunging down to the ocean at Sandwich Harbour. At some point during your stay in Namibia, you may well look around and wonder if you've fallen off the end of the earth. This tends to happen most often along the country's barren, sandswept coastline.

When you visit Namibia with Airborne, you'll climb some of the highest sand dunes in Sossusvlei and be amazed by the barren beauty of Deadvlei, and see the twinkling stars of one of the clearest night skies on earth. You'll meet members of the Himba tribe, the last semi-nomadic people of Namibia. We'll take you on a Marine cruise on Walvis Bay and taste local oysters and experience a 4WD excursion at Sandwich Bay.

Drive to **Cape Cross Seal Reserve (260km)**. The coastline of Southern Africa is the only place in the world where you find Cape fur seals and **the Cape Cross Seal Reserve** is home to the largest breeding colony in the world.



Continue onto **Swakopmund (75km)**. It was of major importance as a harbor during the German colonial era. The appearance of the town, with its 30 000 inhabitants, is characterized by numerous colonial buildings with the Woermann House from 1905 as its landmark.

DAY 9

📍 Walvis Bay Marine & Bay Excursion

Travel to **Walvis Bay** for the **Marine & Dune excursion**.

The tour starts with the **Marine Cruise** where you will see Pelican Point, Oyster Farms, Bird Island, Lighthouse, Walvis Bay Lagoon, Saltpans, Kuseb River Delta and Mudflats of Sandwich Harbour.



After the cruise, enjoy a **4WD excursion into the Dunes**. Your guide & land rover are waiting to meet you, taking you out to the dunes and protected Sandwich harbor area. Enjoy a light lunch on a sandbank.



DAY 10

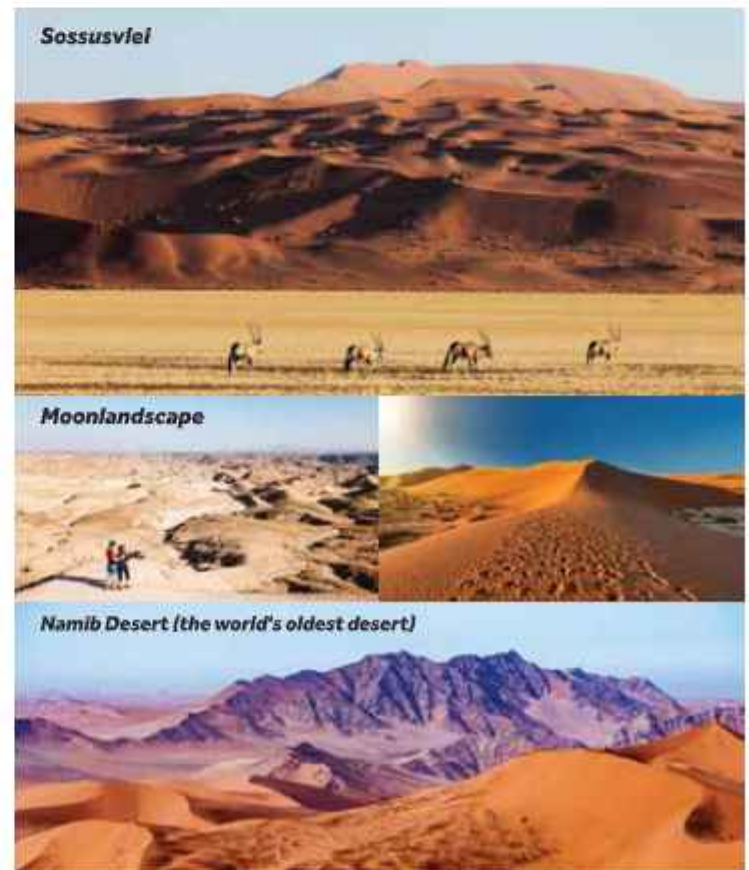
📍 Swakopmund ⇨ Sossusvlei (2N)

Today after breakfast we travel to **Sossusvlei with a drive through Welwitschia Drive and Moonlandscape en route**. Afternoon sunset drive into the desert.

The **Welwitschia** is endemic to Namib Desert. Although the plant looks as if it has many leaves, it has only two. The oldest living specimens are estimated at 1500 to 2000 years.

The **Sossusvlei**, Namibia's famous highlight in the heart of the Namib Desert (the world's oldest desert), is a huge clay pan, enclosed by giant sand dunes. Some of the spectacular hills of sand are highest in the world.

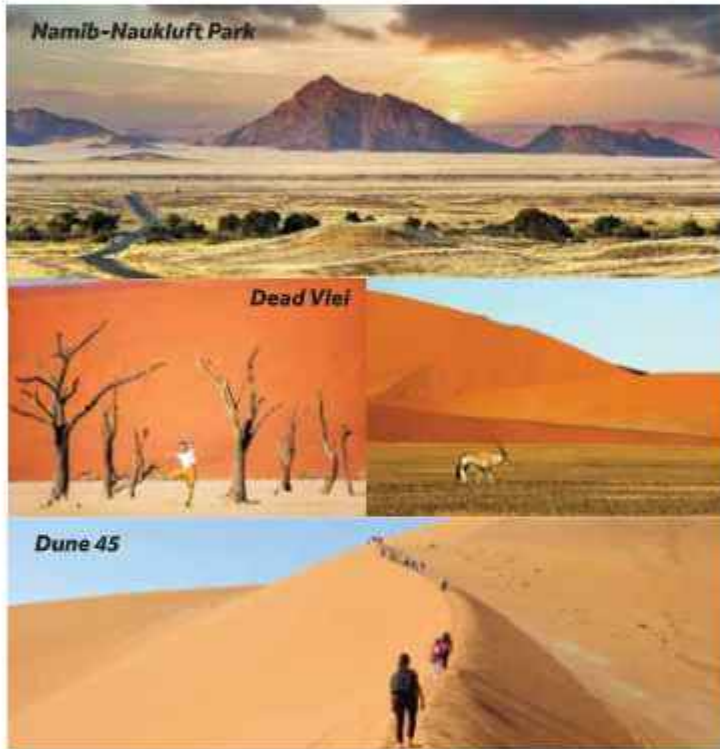

An early start from the Lodge to enter the **Namib-Naukluft Park** at sunrise, while the temperature is still mild and when the dune contrasts are at their best. Your guide who will share all his knowledge of the area, animals, plant life and much more with you.

Regular stops are made on the ±60 kilometre drive down to the Vlei to gain information or take in the vistas. At **Dune 45**, the more energetic have the opportunity to climb to the upper ridge of the world's most photographed dune. Further along, a gradual 2,6 kilometre round-trip walk up to **Dead Vlei** is a must for the healthy visitors. Visit **Sesriem Canyon**.



DAY 12



Sossusvlei → Windhoek

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Depart for **Windhoek**. On arrival enjoy a city tour.

Windhoek sits in the heart of Namibia, in the midst of the country's Central Highlands. Aside from its European population, the city is a rich mix of Namibian ethnicities.

Windhoek → Cape Town, South Africa (3N)

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Transfer to Windhoek Airport for flight to **Cape Town**.

Take a cable-car up **Table Mountain** to view one of the world's most spectacular panoramas. (Visit is weather dependent; should excursion not be possible; it will be moved to the following day – weather permitting).

Enjoy free time at **V&A Waterfront**.

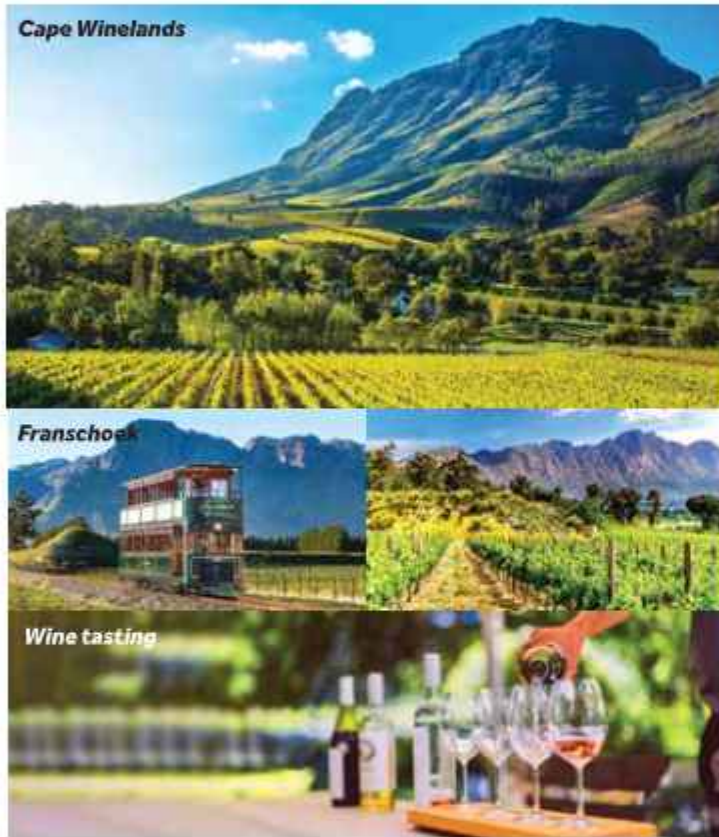
Full Day Cape Winelands Tour

Franschoek – this area was settled by the French Huguenots in 1689 and this Valley of the Vignerons is also known for its quality wines and beautiful scenery.

Stellenbosch, a University Town, also known as the "town of oaks". The Stellenbosch Wine Route was the first wine route to have been developed 40 years ago. The town is currently surrounded by +/- 100 000 hectares of vineyards. The wines of the Cape have a worldwide reputation for quality. It is in this region where you will see various examples of « Cape Dutch » architecture and about 60 of these houses have been declared national monuments.



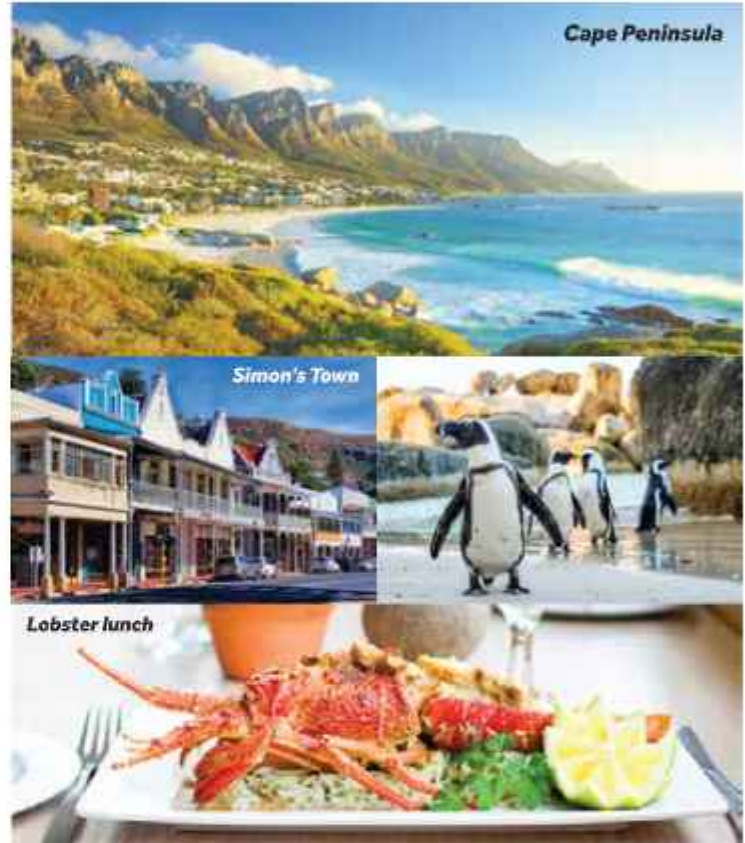
DAY 15

Drive along the Atlantic Coastline passing the areas called Sea Point, Clifton, and Camps Bay before arriving in Hout Bay, a small fishing village, dominated by the scenic Chapman's Peak Pass. Continue to the **Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve**, with its 40 km coastline and which comprises indigenous flora, many species of antelope and abundant birdlife. At the most southerly tip of the reserve, you can climb to the lighthouse and enjoy the views.

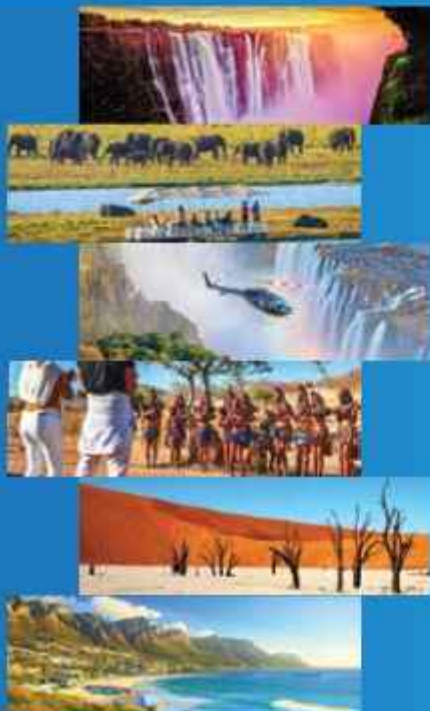

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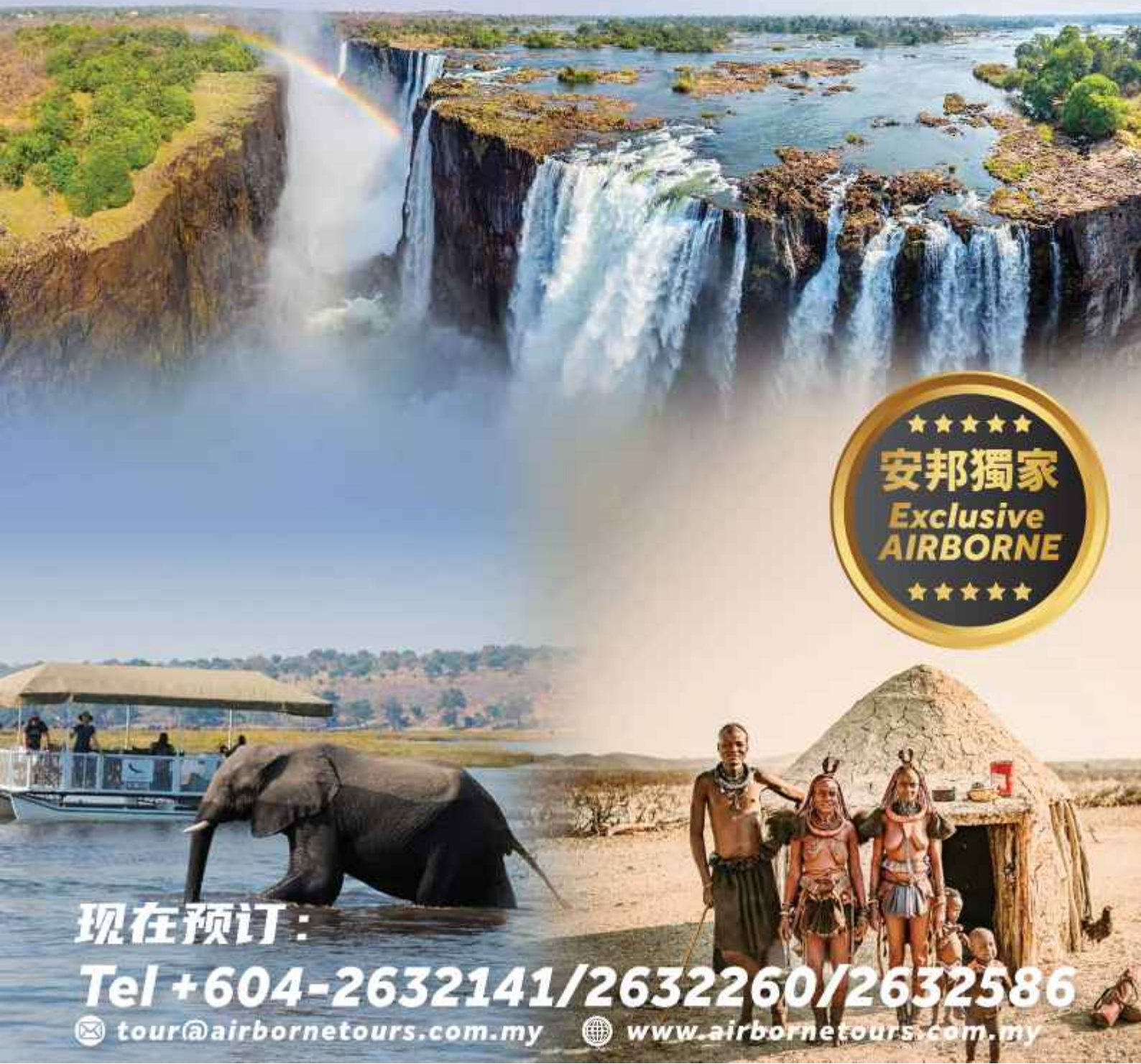

神秘的干湿循环塑造了**乔贝国家公园**，并决定了其野生居民的本性。位于博茨瓦纳北部的乔贝国家公园是非洲象最集中的地方之一。虽然对这些温柔的哺乳动物的观察是乔贝访问的一大亮点，但还有更多值得一看的地方。乔贝也是观鸟的绝佳目的地，拥有众多食草动物，可以看到非洲的一些大型捕食者。

乘坐直升机，在壮丽的世界自然奇观维多利亚瀑布上空享受生活的快感，该直升机恰如其分地命名为“**天使的飞行**”。

游览维多利亚瀑布两岸（津巴布韦和赞比亚—如时间允许）。赞比西河上令人敬畏的美丽和壮丽的壮丽景象，形成了赞比亚和津巴布韦之间的边界。1800年代居住在该地区的科洛洛部落将其描述为“Mosi-ōa-Tunya”——“雷鸣般的烟雾”。用更现代的话来说，维多利亚瀑布被称为世界上最大的落水幕。瀑布每分钟有多达5.45亿升水流过瀑布。下午可以自由活动，独自探索迷人的维多利亚瀑布镇。

傍晚时分，**前往维多利亚瀑布的月球彩虹之旅**，很少有人体验过！每个满月，维多利亚瀑布雨林都会在傍晚重新开放，进行特别游览，见证月球彩虹的神秘魔力 - 在允许的情况下，喷雾和云彩！维多利亚瀑布是地球上为数不多的经常发生这种自然现象并且可以轻松目睹的地方之一。然而，许多人在不知道这种自然现象的情况下参观瀑布，但它是维多利亚瀑布最令人印象深刻的景点之一。月亮彩虹最好在**高水位**（4月至7月）看到，此时有足够的喷雾来产生月虹效果。

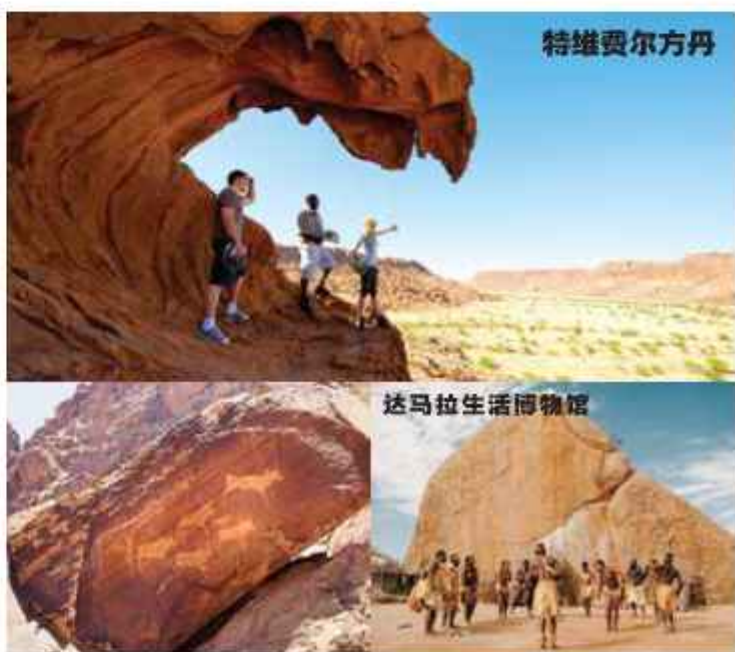

达马拉生活博物馆是一个村庄的社区项目，旨在保护达马拉人的原始传统和生活方式。

纳米比亚

非洲很少有国家能够与纳米比亚的自然美景相媲美，或者令人心旷神怡。全国的这个名字来源于世界上最古老的沙漠纳米布，很少有比这更激动人心的沙漠了。地球上的国度——桑威奇的沙丘坠入海洋的超凡脱俗港口。在您逗留纳米比亚期间的某个时刻，您很可能环顾四周并想知道您是否已经从地球的尽头掉下来。这种情况最常发生在该国的贫瘠地区，沙尘暴的海岸线。

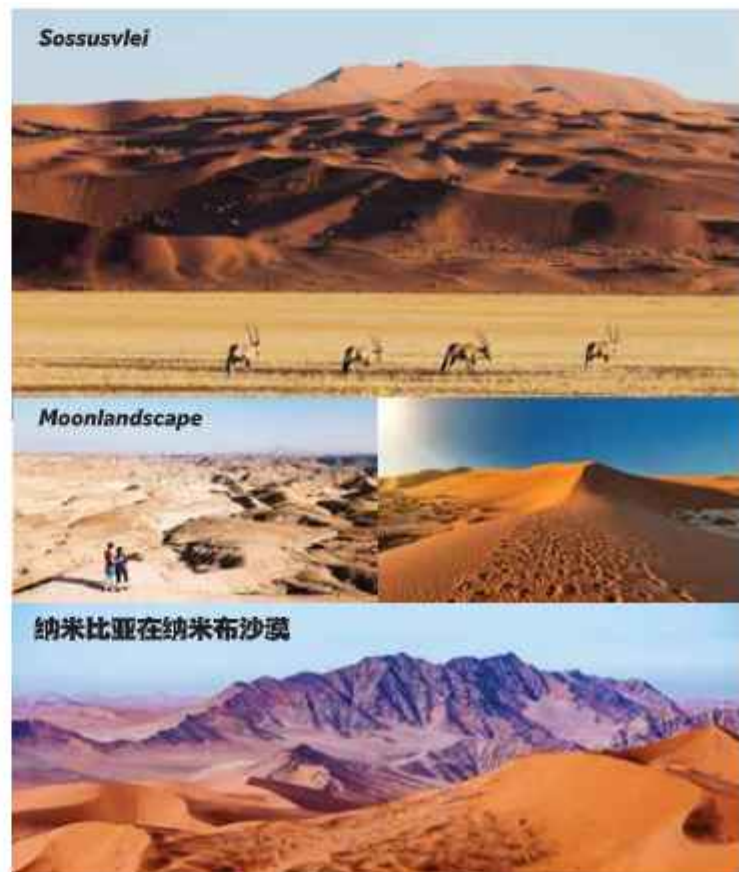

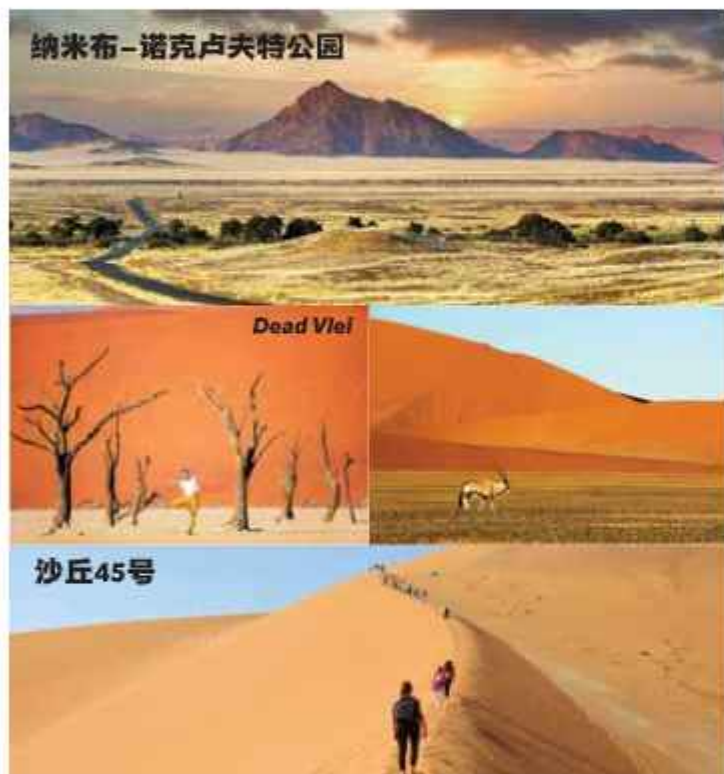

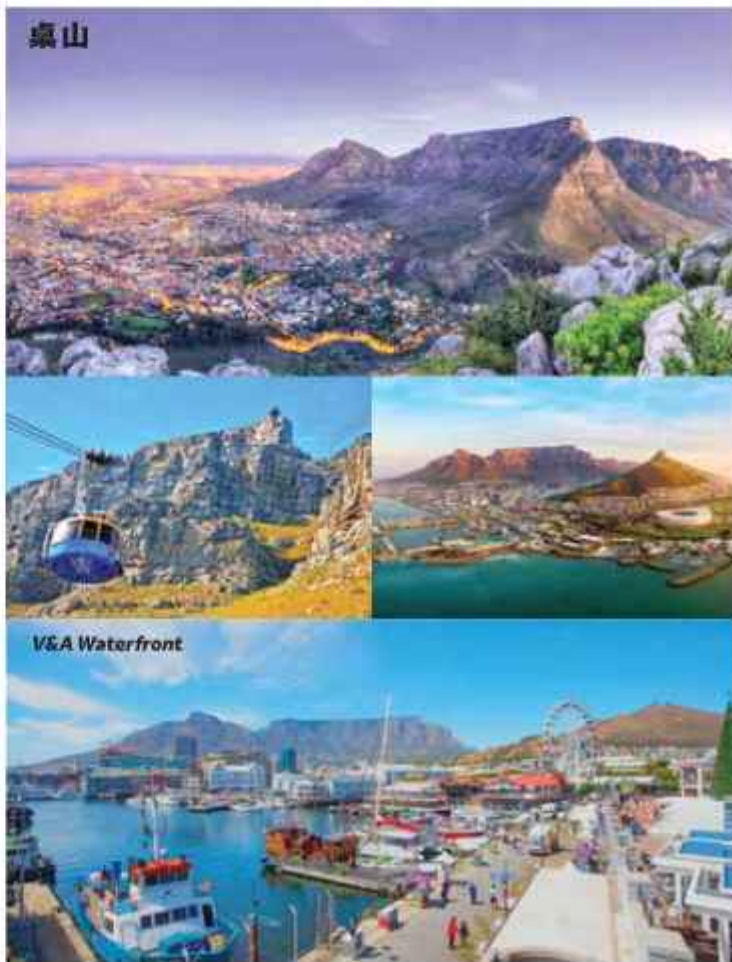
